DIRECTIONS

LOCATION: (34.6041112, -96.7754960)

- ⊗ From Intersection of 3W-19 and OK Hwy 377 in Ada: Go south on OK 1W/3E for 0.9 miles to Roff/Coalgate exit; Take Hwy 1 Latta/Roff/Sulphur exit; Turn right (signs for Roff/Sulphur) and go for 7.9 miles; Turn left (south) onto 3500 Rd and go for 5 miles to shop.
- ⊗ From Tishomingo: Go north on US-377 for 28 miles to 1650 Rd; Go west on 1650 Rd for 8 miles to 3500 Rd; Go south on 3500 Rd for 1.3 miles to shop.
- ⊗ From Sulphur: Go east on State Hwy 7/W Oklahoma Ave for 6.2 miles to T-intersection; Turn north on Hwy 1; Go through Roff on Hwy 1 and turn east on County Rd 1650, then south on County Rd 3500 to shop.
